### Information Collection and Use

The information that we request is retained on your device and is not collected by us in any way. The recorded audio will stay on your device and will only be shared with other parties with the consent of the user through a messenger service or other third party app of the user's choosing. Once the data has been shared via third party software please be aware that we have no control over, and assume no responsibility for the content, privacy policies, or practices of any third-party sites or services.

The app does use third party services that may collect information used to identify you. Google services and the social media that we link to in the app may collect and distribute any information that you choose to share.

We want to inform you that whenever you use our application, in case of an error in the app we collect data and information (through third party products) on your phone called Log Data. This Log Data may include information such as your devices' Internet Protocol ("IP") address, device name, operating system version, configuration of the app when utilising our application, the time and date of your use of the application, and other statistics.

### Cookies

Cookies are files with small amount of data that is commonly used an anonymous unique identifier. These are sent to your browser from the website that you visit and are stored on your device's internal memory.
